

LOCAL PROGRAM PLANNING RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. A public forum on the security of our elections. This is in response to the concerns about the validity and security of the November 2020 election.
- Review/update on the transportation position. The LWV-CC position was a concurrence from LWV-Dallas on the DART (Dallas Area Rapid Transit) and is not as relevant to Collin County nor does it cover all current transportation issues.
- 3. A public forum on transportation. This would only require LWV-CC to hold a public forum on transportation. The agenda and speakers have already been developed but had to be postponed in 2020. This would not require an update on the transportation position.

LOCAL PROGRAM PLANNING SUBMISSIONS THAT WERE NOT ADOPTED

- 1. A public forum on the women's health and maternal mortality. Texas has one of the most concerning maternal mortality rates in the country, particularly for women of color.
- 2. A public forum on criminal justice reform, including police training and the current laws and procedures and the effect on citizens. Research state immunity laws for law enforcement personnel; judgements rendered that disproportionally impact people of color; bonding system that penalizes poor, non-violent offenders with imprisonments.
- 3. A study on conscientious objection to vaccines by parents of school-age children in Collin County. The scope would cover (but not limited to): how many children in Collin County public schools are enrolled per year whose parents have used this claim; if there are any consequences to this for the school and other students, including the spread of disease in the schools; how Collin County compares to other areas of the state in relation to this issue.
